

Q&A with Serita Stevens from the Sci-fi/Horror "The Unborn"

So, Serita, your background, where are you from

and what motivated you to do a Sci-fi/Horror?:

I'm from Chicago originally and I grew up in a home with domestic violence and was motivated to write the short story "The Unborn" based on my experience. I also believe in the fetus being able to hear and experience things while in the womb.

And your role with in "The Unborn"?

My role was to write the story and executive produce it. I also played the part of the doctor as I enjoy acting, as well.

How would you best describe your Sci-fi/Horror Project?

I would best describe it as a true life fantasy in that I think many infants remember things prior to their birth and this is a sci-fi horror with a message.

What was the best moment, for you in creating "The Unborn"?

Probably the best moment for any producer is seeing the finished product, but also knowing that I can get the message across that domestic violence is not acceptable is crucial for me.

And the worst moment?

The worst moment was going over budget and wondering how we were going to finish it! Also there were some crew issues because we had not vetted people properly.

If you had one message to get across to the WORLD with "The Unborn"

- What would that message be?

That domestic violence is unacceptable and that justice does prevail...at least in story life.

Everyone that enters a Festival wants to win an Award,

What about your project makes it stand out?

I think the social issues are what make my film stand out. It's not just about slashing and killing people. It's about real life.

and What is next for you?

We are currently writing a feature and are working on getting investors for that.
